ABOUT

Waipapa Bay is a place of stunning natural beauty - close to the vineyards where the wine is produced. A laid back surf spot beneath the snow-capped Kaikoura Mountains overlooking the Pacific Ocean - where whales are regularly spotted and which inspired the label. In tandem with the launch of the 2019 vintage in the USA, Waipapa Bay Wines has partnered with the Whale and Dolphin Conservation (WDC) Charity as the nonprofit's first wine industry corporate sponsor.

WINEMAKING

In 1987 husband and wife team, Brent and Shirley Rawston, planted three hectares of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir on the banks of the Halswell River in Canterbury, New Zealand. Then in 2004 they ventured into Marlborough and today this family-owned business grows internationally recognised award-winning varieties across 100 acres of vineyards in the Rapaura area of the Wairau Valley. Twenty-four hours of skin contact produces a subtle wine with a beautiful pale salmon hue.

TASTING NOTES

Red fruit aromas with hints of rose petals and summer spices. This wine has a long lingering palate of summer fruits, particularly raspberries and strawberries. Serve lightly chilled, with almost any white meat or fish and vegetables.
